**VISIT TO LUTHERAN CHURCH IN OAXACA**

However, the lay leaders of the congregation have been active in the online courses which David coordinates for Augsburg Lutheran Seminary. The online courses have continued to be very helpful for many churches in the same situation as La Santa Cruz who are unable to afford a full-time pastor and are relying on lay leaders. We are working with leaders not only in Mexico but in other Latin American countries as well.
